TIME Interconnect Technology Announces 2025 Annual Results Profit for the Year Surges by 69% YoY to HK\$783.6 million

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AI Drives Strong Core Business Growth Diversified Strategies Strengthen Risk Resilience Synergies Drive Breakthrough Development of the Group

(27 March 2026, Hong Kong) **TIME Interconnect Technology Limited** (“**TIME Interconnect Technology**” or the “**Company**”, together with its subsidiaries, the “**Group**”; stock code:1729) today announced its annual results for the year ended 31 December 2025 (“the Year”). During the Year, driven by the Artificial Intelligence (“AI”) boom, sales orders from the server sector and data centre in the cable assembly sector increased significantly. The Group recorded revenue of HK\$12,409.6 million, representing a substantial year-on-year (“YoY”) increase of 68.0%. Profit for the Year amounted to HK\$783.6 million, representing a significant YoY increase of 69.0%. Operating profit totalled HK\$907.8 million, representing an increase of 44.4% compared with the previous year. Basic earnings per share was HK40.1 cents. Given the Group’s sound financial position and promising business prospects, the Board has recommended the payment of a final dividend of HK2.4 cents per share, amounting to approximately HK\$50.2 million in total.

Mr. Simon Cua, Chief Executive Officer and Executive Director of the Group, said, “We are pleased to see the Group successfully seize development opportunities in the AI field, driving a leap forward in its core businesses and achieving another performance milestone. The global economic outlook is full of uncertainties, affected by the U.S. tariff hikes and the geopolitical situation. Amid this complex environment, the Group has further expanded its global footprint and diversified its business portfolio through a number of strategic acquisitions and investments, laying a solid foundation for long-term sustainable growth.”

AI empowers core growth with diversified businesses advancing in parallel

All of the Group’s business sectors achieved outstanding performance during the Year. Benefiting from the booming AI industry, related businesses have become the core growth engine of the Group. The revenue of the server sector and data centre sector significantly increased by 132.1% and 49.4%, respectively, as compared with the previous year. At the same time, the development of AI has also driven sustained growth in demand for high-speed cables in the specialty cable sector. Revenue from this sector increased by 10.5%, making a positive contribution to the Group’s overall profitability.

Alongside the rapid growth of AI-related businesses, the Group's diversified business portfolio has also continued to improve. The industrial equipment sector delivered an impressive 72.6% increase in revenue, while the automotive sector successfully capitalised on orders shifting to Mexico amid changes in tariff policies, and achieved an 8.8% rise in revenue.

Proactively expanding into the medical equipment sector and synergistically driving the development of the healthcare industry

During the Year, the Group continued to deepen its presence in the medical equipment sector, expanding its medical equipment customer base and strengthening its R&D capabilities. Despite uncertainties in the external trade environment, the Group's medical equipment cables business performed steadily, with revenue growing by 4.6%. To further expand its business portfolio, following the two investments completed in 2024, the Group invested in one more UK-based startup company in April 2025. This company specialises in the research and development of wearable robotic devices that combine textiles, copper wire and AI technologies to help strengthen muscles and prevent falls. Its business aligns with the Group's upstream copper wire procurement and the production and automation capabilities of its controlling shareholder, Luxshare Precision, and is expected to generate strong synergies in medical product R&D, manufacturing, and market expansion.

In January 2025, Mr. Cua Tin Yin Simon, Chief Executive Officer and Executive Director of the Group, took the initiative to promote and establish the Medical Engineering & Innovation Council ("MEIC") under the Federation of Hong Kong Industries ("FHKI"), and served as its co-chairman. Positioned as a "super-connector", MEIC is committed to strengthening collaboration between the industry, government, research institutions, academia and the financial sector, facilitating product commercialisation, and raising awareness of Hong Kong's strengths and capabilities in medical engineering in both local and overseas markets. At the same time, MEIC also actively promotes the transformation of traditional industries and supports the financing of start-ups. While expanding into overseas markets, it advances the in-depth integration of the industrial chain between China and Hong Kong, thereby further consolidating Hong Kong's international standing in medical engineering and innovation. Furthermore, the Group, in conjunction with MEIC, co-hosted the inaugural "Hong Kong Medtech Innovation World Cup" and strategically supported the "WT | Wearable Technology Conference" in jointly exploring the industrialisation route of cutting-edge medical technologies and contributing to the development of Hong Kong's medical innovation ecosystem.

Strategic acquisitions expand global presence and bolster vertical integration advantages

During the Year, the Group, through two major acquisitions, took important steps toward expanding its global business footprint and strengthening its supply chain layout. As the Group's controlling shareholder, Luxshare Precision Industry leveraged Luxshare Group's platform advantages and market position to introduce strategic resources to the Group, thereby further enhancing the Group's future growth potential. In July 2025, the Group acquired Leoni Kable GmbH ("Leoni Kable") – a renowned century-old brand in the cable industry – via Time Interconnect Singapore Pte. Ltd. ("Time Singapore"), a joint venture set up in Singapore with Luxshare Precision Industry. The acquisition brought Leoni Kable's production and R&D facilities across Europe, the US and Asia into the Group's

business ecosystem and created opportunities for the Group to expand its product portfolio and enhance its global influence.

Furthermore, the Group acquired DJC Group in December 2025. As a leading manufacturer of copper wire products, DJC Group has production facilities in China and Southeast Asia. The acquisition will significantly bolster the Group's supply chain resilience, help effectively mitigate geographical and political risks, and secure a stable supply of critical raw materials. This move will not only strengthen the Group's quality control over upstream raw materials and improve product R&D efficiency, but will also enable the Group to leverage DJC Group's solid business network in China and the Asia-Pacific region to deepen market penetration and further enhance its core competitiveness.

Navigating macroeconomic challenges and seizing emerging growth opportunities

According to the latest forecast by the International Monetary Fund, global economic growth will continue to slow down in 2026, and policy uncertainties and geopolitical tensions will pose challenges to the global business environment. However, as AI technology drives ongoing productivity gains, it is expected to generate broad economic benefits and create long-term development opportunities.

Despite a complex and volatile macroeconomic environment, the Group maintains a positive outlook on potential market demand, especially regarding the development potential of high-growth sectors, including AI, data centres, and medical technology. Regarding the server and data centre business, supported by China's active promotion of digital infrastructure development and national policies such as the "channelling computing resources from the eastern areas to the western regions", as well as Luxshare Precision Industry's platform advantages, the Group will continue to meet the deep customisation needs of brand customers and strive to become an all-rounded network solutions and infrastructure provider. At the same time, the Group will continue to actively pursue high-quality investment opportunities and expand its operations across more countries and regions, thereby diversifying business risks and enhancing its risk-resistance amid an uncertain global operating environment.

The Group also sees growing demand in the medical equipment market, driven by rising health awareness among the public since the pandemic, and expects demand for medical equipment cables to continue rising, which should have a positive effect on orders in the coming year. By investing in medical and healthcare-related companies, the Group seeks to foster synergies in medical product R&D, manufacturing, and global market expansion, strengthening its portfolio and supporting diversified growth.

Mr. Simon Cua added, "Looking back on 2025, the Group accurately grasped burgeoning opportunities in the AI industry and achieved outstanding results. Going forward, the Group will further develop the AI-related server and data centre business, advance the strategic layout of the medical equipment segment, and leverage Luxshare Group's established industrial ecosystem platform and market leadership to unleash long-term growth momentum. The Group firmly believes that its strategic alliance with Luxshare Precision Industry will enable efficient integration and resource sharing across

customer networks and market channels, while further benefiting from synergies arising from the development of the telecommunications, data communications, medical and healthcare, automotive, and industrial sectors. Backed by Luxshare Precision Industry, the Group is confident in tapping broader development opportunities and achieving breakthrough growth in the future.”
